

Report on the provision of medical services related to reproductive health care - 2024.

The Bureau of Vital Statistics releases an annual report for the most up to date data collected by the New York City (NYC) Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (Health Department), the most recent report is for 2021 City statistics. These are the data reported herein; the Health Department does not collect and publish any additional data on reproductive health care services.

The Health Department collects and publishes information on births ("live births") and abortions ("induced terminations"). For data regarding live births and abortions by borough of residence and age for NYC residents and non-residents, see Table 1. For data regarding abortions by age and racial/ethnic groups for NYC residents and non-residents, see Table 2. For data regarding live births and abortions by racial/ethnic groups, age, and borough of residence for NYC residents only, see Table 3.

The Health Department is unable to maintain a list of licensed medical providers that provide reproductive health care services. New York State Department of Health has oversight over licensure of medical providers and maintains current records related to providers in NYC and State. Reproductive health care encompasses a broad array of physical and mental health services. The NYC Health Department does not have the capacity or resources to assess the ability of licensed medical providers in the city to accommodate individuals seeking medical services related to reproductive health care. However, according to our 2022 community health survey, 97% of NYC women who have needed contraception or abortion services in the last 12 months were able to access it.
