






Kowteff's 14th Annual Juneteenth Celebration

Grand Central Station Full Scale Exercise Support Postponed for July 12 -13








Councilmember Mercedes Narcisse Haitian Flag Celebration

Manhattan Division 3 Monthly Team Meeting





THINGS TO KNOW



How To Request NYC CERT

If approached to support an event in your community, the following steps must be taken:

- Event organizer submits an official request using the <u>NYC CERT External Request Form</u>.
- NYC CERT Leadership *should not* submit form on behalf of the event organizer.
- For events lead by a NYC CERT Division, volunteer leadership (Ready New York Liaison, if a preparedness event) should submit this <u>Event</u> <u>Request form</u>

NYC CERT program staff will review all requests. If approved, program staff will add the volunteer opportunity to the <u>NYC CERT Event Calendar</u>

with a registration link. If more details are required for approval, program staff will use the

contact information provided in the request form to connect with the organizer.


