COMMISSION DIRECTIVE: NEW YEAR'S EVE 2022 STREET CLOSURES

To all licensees and registrants:

On New Year's Eve, December 31, street access will be restricted in Manhattan, with connecting streets from 37th Street to 59th Street between Fifth Avenue and Ninth Avenue closed to all motor vehicles, including trade waste collection vehicles. The street closures will remain in effect from Saturday, December 31, 2022 through the morning of Sunday, January 1, 2023.

All licensees and registrants are hereby directed to complete waste collection and remove all containers in the affected areas before 4:00 a.m. on December 31, 2022. Collection may resume at 6:00 a.m. on January 1, 2023. Moreover, all licensees and registrants must notify all customers along the event route that no waste may be placed on the curbside between 4:00 a.m. December 31, 2022 through 4:00 a.m. January 1, 2023. Commission enforcement agents will be on the event route to ensure compliance with this Directive.

Please be aware that the City's Department of Transportation ("DOT") issued a holiday construction embargo that is in place until Monday, January 2, 2023. DOT will strictly enforce this embargo and violators are subject to being summonsed. For information regarding the DOT embargo area please see:
