NALOXONE MEDICATION CARRIED BY SERVICE LEVEL:

Advanced Life Support – 2 vials 4mg / 2ml each dose (Carried in medication insert).

Basic Life Support - 2 vials 4mg / 2ml each dose.

Certified First Responder - 2 vials 4mg / 2ml each dose.

On hand at Pharmacy – 1,500 vials.

- The above units carry 2 atomizer devices each to dispense naloxone.
- ALS and BLS equipped with the DOH Leave Behind Kits for distribution to patients when applicable 8mg each dose.
