COMMISSION DIRECTIVE

Dear Licensees and Registrants:

The 2017 Presidential Inauguration will be held on Friday, January 20, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. In anticipation of this event, on January 19, 2017, the New York City Police Department will temporarily close various connecting streets and avenues between 56th Street and 62nd Street, which will include partial intermittent closures of the FDR Drive to all motor vehicles, including trade waste collection vehicles.

Accordingly, all Licensees and Registrants are hereby directed to complete waste collection and remove their respective containers along the event route (described below) before 6:00 a.m. on January 19, 2017. Collection may resume at 6:00 a.m. on January 20, 2017. Moreover, all Licensees and Registrants must notify all customers along the event route that no waste or containers may be placed on the curbside between 12:00 a.m. Thursday, January 19, 2017 to 5:00 a.m. Friday, January 20, 2017.

The following streets in Manhattan will be closed to all vehicles:

- Sutton Place between 56th Street and 62nd Street.
- 56th Street between Madison Avenue and Sutton Place.

Business Integrity Commission (“BIC”) enforcement agents will be on the event route to ensure compliance with this Directive. Failure to comply with this Directive may result in administrative penalties and/or fines up to \$10,000. *See* 17 RCNY 1-09. Failure to comply with this Directive may also affect your company’s licensing or registration status before BIC.
