EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4

IN ORDER TO CARRY OUT AND PROTECT THE PRINCIPLES WHICH UNDERline the provisions of Article V, Section 6 of the Constitution, to preserve the Civil Service merit system and to avoid favoritism and improper and unjust discrimination, all heads of City agencies are hereby directed to make appointments and promotions from eligible lists promulgated after competitive examinations only in the order in which the names of available candidates appear upon such eligible lists, except with the written approval of the Mayor upon good and sufficient cause being shown.
