The water level changes will begin March 3 rd and will disturb the existing ice pack. This may create unsafe weak spots in the ice that will not be readily apparent to people walking on the surface.</div> <div>Regular fishing from the shoreline will not be affected and will remain available to people who have a valid DEP Access Permit.</div> <div>DEP has begun to post closure notices at all the main ice fishing points at West Branch and is also contacting members of the fishing community.
