REMEMBERING THE FALLEN: NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF SANITATION TO UNVEIL 'FOREVER STRONGEST' SCULPTURE HONORING ITS ESSENTIAL WORKERS LOST TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC

DSNY leadership will join families of those we've lost to unveil the memorial before its display at locations across the city

EVENT DATE: Thursday, May 20, 2021 – The New York City Department of Sanitation, the world's largest municipal sanitation agency, will unveil its permanent memorial sculpture, known as *Forever Strongest*, honoring members of the Department who lost their lives to the COVID-19 pandemic. DSNY – whose employees are known as *New York's Strongest* for their work ensuring a clean, safe, and healthy city – has suffered nine confirmed COVID-19 fatalities. Over 20% of the Department's approximately 9,500 employees have tested positive for COVID-19 since March of 2020.
