What authorizes the Department to make this amendment? Section 389(b) of the New York City Charter provides that "heads of mayoral agencies shall have the power to adopt rules to carry out the powers and duties delegated to the agency head or the agency by or pursuant to federal, state or local law." Section 1043(a) of the Charter similarly provides that each "agency is empowered to adopt rules necessary to carry out the powers and duties delegated to it by or pursuant to federal, state or local law." Section 27-2029 of the New York City Administrative Code sets the minimum temperature to be furnished in dwellings where centrally-supplied heat is required to be provided.

Where can I find the Department rules and the Health Code? The Department's rules and the Health Code are located in Title 24 of the Rules of the City of New York.

What laws govern the rulemaking process? The Department must satisfy the requirements of Section 1043 of the Charter when adding or amending rules. This notice is made according to the requirements of Section 1043(b) of the Charter.

Statement of Basis and Purpose of Proposed Rule

Local Law 86 of 2017 amended paragraph 2 of subdivision a of § 27-2029 of the New York City Administrative Code to mandate that dwellings in which centrally-supplied heat is required maintain a minimum temperature of 62 degrees Fahrenheit between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. during the period of October $1^{\rm st}$ to May $31^{\rm st}$ regardless of the outside temperature. The Department is proposing to update section 131.07 of the New York City Health Code ("Health Code") to align with the current overnight temperature requirement of section 27-2029.

The Department proposes an additional amendment to section 131.07 to clarify that enforcement of complaints about inadequate heat in multiple dwellings is being handled by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD).

Finally, the Department proposes to eliminate the appeal process in section 131.19 for cases when the Commissioner declines a request to modify provisions of Article 131 as they apply to a specific property. Such an appeal is not required by law and is an inefficient use of agency resources, and this proposal would conform the modification provision in 131.19 to modification provisions in other articles of the Health Code.

Statutory Authority

The authority for these rules is found in the New York City Charter §§ 556 and 1043 of the New York City Charter and § 27-2029 of the New York City Administrative Code.

The proposed amendment is as follows:

"Shall" and "must" denote mandatory requirements and may be used interchangeably in the rules of this Department, unless otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Deleted material is in [brackets]; new text is underlined; ellipses (***) indicate unamended text.

Section 1. RESOLVED, that paragraph (1) of subdivision (c) of section 131.07 of Article 131 of the New York City Health Code, set forth in Title 24 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended, and a new subdivision (e) is added, to read as follows:

(c) Unless otherwise provided by written contract or lease, or as provided by applicable law, including this Code, the minimum temperatures required by subdivision (a) of this section shall be maintained as follows:

(1) [In a dwelling, during the months between October first and May thirty-first between the hours of six a.m. and ten p.m.: a

temperature of at least 68 degrees F when the outside temperature falls below 55 degrees F (12.78 degrees C) and during the hours between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. a temperature of at least 55 degrees F (12.78 degrees C) whenever the outside temperature falls below 40 degrees F (4.44 degrees C)] A minimum temperature shall be maintained as required in subdivision a of § 27-2029 of the Administrative Code in any dwelling covered by such section; and

(e) In multiple dwellings, violations of and orders requiring compliance with this section may be issued by the Department, or by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development, or any successor agency.

Section 2. RESOLVED, that section 131.19 of Article 131 of the New York City Health Code, set forth in Title 24 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§131.19 Modification by Commissioner. When the strict application of any provision of this article presents practical difficulties or unusual hardships, the Commissioner, in a specific instance, may modify the application of such provision consistent with the general purpose of this article and upon such condition as, in [his or her] their opinion are necessary to protect life and health. [The denial by the Commissioner of a request for modification may be appealed to the Board in the manner provided pursuant to 24 RCNY Health Code § 5.21.]

PRIORITIZING HOUSING PRODUCTION AND ACCELERATING THE PRODUCTION OF HOUSING ON CITY SITES

WHEREAS, New York City is experiencing a housing shortage that must be addressed through the production of additional housing at all levels of affordability; and

WHEREAS, the Department of City Planning projects that the City must add at least 500,000 new housing units this decade to address unmet housing needs; and

WHEREAS, the New York City Housing and Vacancy Survey recently found that the city's vacancy rate – a measure of the city's housing stock available for rent – has dropped to a mere 1.4%, the lowest this measure has been since 1968; and

WHEREAS, New York City and its agencies own and control land throughout the five boroughs that could support additional production of housing; and

WHEREAS, decisions across City government – from regulation, to administration, to planning – have consequences for housing production and thereby affect the health, safety, and welfare of New Yorkers.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Establishment of the Taskforce. There is hereby established an interagency City Housing Activation Taskforce (the "Task Force").

- a. The Task Force shall be chaired by the Deputy Mayor for Housing, Economic Development and Workforce or such Deputy Mayor's designee (the "Chair"), or the successor to such Deputy Mayor or their designee;
- b. The Task Force shall consist of representatives from Mayoral agencies and offices, including the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, the Department of Environmental Protection, the Department of Housing, Preservation and Development, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Department of Sanitation, the Department of Transportation, the Fire Department, the Police Department, and the Office of Management and Budget, and representatives from other agencies or entities designated by the Chair;
- c. The Task Force shall also seek the participation and cooperation of additional public and other entities as the Chair deems appropriate, provided that such entities shall include the New York Public Library, the Queens Public Library, the Brooklyn Public Library, the New York City Economic Development Corporation, the New York City Department of Education, the New York City Housing Authority, and the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation. The Chair may invite any of these or other entities as designated by the Chair to participate on the Task Force in accordance with subdivision (b) of this Section.
- § 2. Duties of the Task Force.

- a. The Task Force shall:
- Review all land under the ownership and control of the City or
 of other participating and cooperating agencies and entities, and
 enlist the collaboration of City agencies and such other agencies
 and entities, to identify potential sites for housing development
 and to determine if such sites could be used to further housing
 production on such sites or on adjacent or nearby sites without
 disruption to critical operations;
- ii. Develop guidelines to ensure that all designated City agencies and other participating and cooperating agencies and entities consider, to the extent practicable, the effect of agency policies and practices on housing production and strive to update policies and practices to promote housing production.
- \S 3. This Order shall take effect immediately, and shall expire and be deemed revoked on December 31, 2025.

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EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 657 September 20, 2024

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2021, the federal monitor in the *Nunez* use-of-force class action stated that steps must be taken immediately to address the conditions in the New York City jails; and

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2022, the federal court in Nunez approved the Nunez Action Plan, which "represents a way to move forward with concrete measures now to address the ongoing crisis at Rikers Island"; and

WHEREAS, although there has been improvement in excessive staff absenteeism, extraordinarily high rates of attrition due to staff retirements and other departures continue to seriously affect the Department of Correction's (DOC's) staffing levels and create a serious risk to DOC's ability to carry out the safety and security measures required for the maintenance of sanitary conditions; and access to basic services, including showers, meals, visitation, religious services, commissary, and recreation; and

WHEREAS, this Order is given to prioritize compliance with the Nunez Action Plan and to address the effects of DOC's staffing levels, the conditions at DOC facilities, and health operations; and

WHEREAS, additional reasons for requiring the measures continued in this Order are set forth in Emergency Executive Order No. 140 of 2022, Emergency Executive Order No. 579 of 2024, and Emergency Executive Order 623 of 2024; and

WHEREAS, the state of emergency existing within DOC facilities, first declared in Emergency Executive Order No. 241, dated September 15, 2021, and extended by subsequent orders, remains in effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the laws of the State of New York and the City of New York, including but not limited to the New York Executive Law, the New York City Charter and the Administrative Code of the City of New York, and the common law authority to protect the public in the event of an emergency:

Section 1. I hereby direct that section 1 of Emergency Executive Order No. 654, dated September 15, 2024, is extended for five (5) days.

§ 2. This Emergency Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless it is terminated or modified at an earlier date.

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EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 658 September 20, 2024

WHEREAS, it is of utmost importance to protect the health and safety of all persons in the custody of the Department of Correction ("DOC"), and of all officers and persons who work in the City of New York jails and who transport persons in custody to court and other facilities, and the public; and

WHEREAS, over 80 provisions in the various Court Orders entered in *Nunez v. City of New York*, 11 CV 5845 (SDNY), require DOC to consult with, and seek the approval of, the *Nunez* Monitor ("Monitor") prior to implementing or amending policies on issues, including but not limited to, matters relating to security practices, the use of restraints, escorts, emergency lock-ins, de-escalation, confinement management of incarcerated individuals following serious

acts of violence and subsequent housing strategies, and DOC may be held in contempt of court and sanctioned if it fails to appropriately consult with and obtain approval from the Monitor regarding policies in these areas; and

WHEREAS, as fully detailed in Emergency Executive Order 579 of 2024, DOC is already experiencing a significant staffing crisis, which poses a serious risk to the health, safety, and security of all people in custody and to DOC personnel; and

WHEREAS, attempting to comply with many of the provisions of Local Law 42 and the new BOC regulations, such as transporting individuals to court without restraints, would require a massive increase in staff and other resources, which are not available; and

WHEREAS, even if DOC had such additional staffing and resources, that still would not obviate the direct threat to public safety posed by certain provisions of Local Law 42, nor would it obviate the fact that the Monitor has yet to approve implementation of those provisions as required by the *Nunez* Orders, nor would it obviate the fact that additional time would be needed to safely implement those provisions of Local Law 42 eventually approved by the Monitor, because, as the Monitor has expressly cautioned, the safe implementation of any new requirement or reform in DOC facilities requires planning time to "evaluat[e] the operational impact, update[e] policies and procedures, update[e] the physical plant, determin[e] the necessary staffing complement, develop[] training materials, and provid[e] training to thousands of staff, all of which must occur before the changes in practice actually go into effect" [11 CV 5845 (SDNY) Dkt No. 758-3 at p. 61]; and

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2024, I issued Emergency Executive Order No. 624, and declared a state of emergency to exist within the correction facilities operated by the DOC, and such declaration remains in effect:

WHEREAS, additional reasons for requiring the measures continued in this Order are set forth in Emergency Executive Order No. 625, dated July 27, 2024; and

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the laws of the State of New York and the City of New York, including but not limited to the New York Executive Law, the New York City Charter and the Administrative Code of the City of New York, and the common law authority to protect the public in the event of an emergency:

Section 1. I hereby direct section 1 of Emergency Executive Order No. 655, dated September 15, 2024 is extended for five (5) days

§ 2. This Emergency Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless it is terminated or modified at an earlier date.

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EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 659 September 20, 2024

WHEREAS, over the past several months, thousands of asylum seekers have been arriving in New York City, from the Southern border, without having any immediate plans for shelter; and

WHEREAS, the City now faces an unprecedented humanitarian crisis that requires it to take extraordinary measures to meet the immediate needs of the asylum seekers while continuing to serve the tens of thousands of people who are currently using the DHS Shelter System; and

WHEREAS, additional reasons for requiring the measures continued in this Order are set forth in Emergency Executive Order No. 224, dated October 7, 2022, and Emergency Executive Order No. 538, dated December 27, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the state of emergency based on the arrival of thousands of individuals and families seeking asylum, first declared in Emergency Executive Order No. 224, dated October 7, 2022, and extended by subsequent orders, remains in effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the laws of the State of New York and the City of New York, including but not limited to the New York Executive Law, the New York City Charter and the Administrative Code of the City of New York, and the common law authority to protect the public in the event of an emergency:

Section 1. I hereby order that section 1 of Emergency Executive Order No. 656, dated September 15, 2024, is extended for five (5) days.

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 \S 2. This Emergency Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless it is terminated or modified at an earlier date.
