FROM THREE WEEK HURRICANE MARIA EMERGENCY DEPLOYMENT IN PUERTO RICO

The Department of Sanitation will welcome home 31 Sanitation Workers and Officers Sunday evening, October 29th (Jet Blue, Terminal 5, JFK) from a three week emergency deployment in Puerto Rico where they provided critical assistance with debris removal management from the devastation of Hurricane Maria. (FYI: Jet Blue flew the team there and back at no cost to the city.)

Welcoming home the DSNY team will be family members, the DSNY Ceremonial Unit, uniformed DSNY officers and the DSNY Emerald Society Pipes and Drums.
