**NYC COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS STATEMENT ON THE US SUPREME COURT
RULING ON *OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE SCHOOL V. MORRISSEY-BERRU***

NEW YORK - Protecting religious freedom and ending workplace discrimination has always been a balance but one that the City of New York has navigated successfully for decades under the NYC Human Rights Law. Today's Supreme Court decision in *Our Lady of Guadalupe School* may make it more difficult to root out discrimination faced by teachers in religious schools—a disheartening decision that is out of step with the commonsense protections most workers enjoy.
