Health & Safety Protocol

As NYCEM's Human Capital Bureau continues to review submissions relating to the Vaccine Mandate, NYCEM will continue sharing updates including the NYC CERT Newsletter and requests with membership with the understanding there is approval needed prior to any in-person deployments and events.

As of Tuesday, February 1, 2022, volunteers

who did not submit appropriate documentation to meet the vaccine mandate or request a reasonable accommodation through NYCEM will soon be placed as inactive until they are in compliance.

- To submit vaccination records, please e-mail an approved proof of vaccination to: <u>CERTVaxVerification@oem.nyc.gov</u>.
- Please review necessary steps **HERE**.

All members placed inactive as a result of incompliance may be re-activated within two years (February 2024) if the proper documentation is submitted and approved.







NYC CERT had a very busy January with planned and unplanned deployments. As we kicked off the year with the Polar Bear plunge, one of our members, Britta Husack, provided CPR to a participant resuscitating him and saving his life. There was then a tragic fire in the Bronx that necessitated the opening of a service center that CERT volunteers from all over the city deployed to support in various roles. During the run of the service center, NYCEM hosted two unique trainings, one provided by NYCEM staff and the other provided by our very own NYC CERT volunteer, Eva Chavez with a Human Trafficking awareness presentation. As the month came to a close, FDNY Ceremonial unit requested CERT support for two ceremonies for fallen NYPD officers, allowing members to serve first responders on the scene and stand with them. And last but not, least, New York City saw it's first significant snowfall for 2022, with 26 volunteers citywide participating in the snow measuring operation.



Winter Weather Emergency Activation Plan Jan 28-29

NYC CERT members provided snow measurements for the first time using our new ArcGIS integration. Measurements were provided both through the mobile application, which has the ability to use your GPS location to pinpoint your location and also on the web browser where you can manually input your location. This new application allows the data to be shared simultaneously between NYC Emergency Management Executive Leadership, National Weather Service, the Mayor's office, and other city agency leadership responding to the weather event.

Great work! We hope to expand the use of this application in the future - so more to come!


