COMMISSION DIRECTIVE

Dear Licensees and Registrants:

New York City's annual Summer Streets program will be held on the first three Saturdays in August: August 5, August 12, and August 19, 2017, from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. each day. Summer Streets will temporarily close Park Avenue and connecting streets from the Brooklyn Bridge to Central Park to all motor vehicles, including trade waste collection vehicles.

All Licensees and Registrants must complete waste collection along the event route by 4:00 a.m. on Saturdays August 5, August 12, and August 19, 2017. Collection may resume at 2:00 p.m. each day. Business Integrity Commission (BIC) enforcement agents will be on the event route each Saturday to ensure compliance with this Directive. A map of the Summer Streets route showing closed streets is annexed hereto and available on the BIC website and at http://www.nyc.gov/html/dot/downloads/pdf/summer_street_embmap.pdf.

Please be aware that the City's Department of Transportation (DOT) issued a construction embargo along the event route from 12:01 a.m. on Monday July 31, 2017, through 6:00 p.m. on Saturday August 19, 2017. DOT will strictly enforce this embargo and violators are subject to be summonsed. A map showing the DOT embargo area is annexed hereto and is available at www.nyc.gov/dot.

Failure to comply with this Directive may result in administrative penalties and/or fines up to \$10,000. See 17 RCNY 1-09. Failure to comply with this Directive may also affect your company's licensing or registration status before BIC.
