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NOTES

- This report is presented in accordance with the requirements set forth in section 17-199.12 of the administrative code of the city of New York.
- The report reflects data from the New York City Early Intervention Program (EI) for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 (FY2021).
- The EI Program provides developmental services to children ages birth to three with developmental delays and disabilities.
- The EI Program does not provide medical services, nursing services, psychological services, or health services.
- This report includes all data required per section 17-199.12 of the New York City Administrative Code except the following items, which the New York Early Intervention System (NYEIS) does not capture:
 - Classification of children by housing status (e.g., homeless, residing in temporary housing)
 - Classification of homeless shelters, childcare providers, and nonprofit organizations as referral sources
 - IFSP Recommendations for sign language or cued language services
 - Service authorization data for children who have transferred to another NY EI jurisdiction
- If a category contains between one and five children or allows another category to be narrowed to between one and five children, the number has been replaced with an asterisk. A category that contains zero children has been reported as zero, unless such reporting would violate any applicable provision of federal, state, or local law relating to personally identifiable information.

INTRODUCTION

The Early Intervention (EI) Program is a Federal entitlement program created as Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act to provide services to children under three years old with developmental delays and disabilities. In New York City, the EI Program is administered by the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Bureau of Early Intervention. EI services, which are provided through a network of agencies in contract with the NYS Department of Health, are available regardless of families' race, ethnicity, income, or immigration status, at no cost to them.

The Bureau of Early Intervention is committed to ensuring that all eligible children have access to EI services, and is focused on reducing disparities in access, particularly among Black children, who make up only 17% of children referred although they are 21% of the birth to three years population in New York City. In recent years, the Bureau has strengthened outreach to communities with low rates of referral and retention in the Program. The Bureau has developed partnerships with community organizations and other City agencies to address misconceptions and stigma about the EI Program, and to improve transitions across health and education systems. It has also collaborated with academic institutions to provide opportunities for students to work in EI agencies, and to encourage them to establish a career in EI. The goal of this initiative is not only to grow the workforce, but also to draw service coordinators and interventionists from the neighborhoods and cultures that are currently less likely to participate in the Program. Most recently, the Bureau has partnered with four hospital systems to increase referral and retention of children in primary care practices that serve communities with low rates of referral.

FY2021 Highlights

After a significant decrease during the COVID-19 pandemic, referrals to the NYC EI Program began rebounding in FY2021 – from 35,115 in FY2019, referrals had dropped to 29,275 in FY2020, and rose to 31,992 in FY2021. There was no change in the number of multidisciplinary evaluations submitted in FY2021 versus FY2020; the proportion of children evaluated who were found eligible increased from 53% to 57%. The number of children receiving services decreased from 31,798 in FY2020 to 30,393 in FY2021 – a consequence of the previous year's decline in referrals. There was improvement in number of days from Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) meeting to first service, which decreased from 18.4 days to 15.9 days; and in percentage of children receiving all services within 30 days of IFSP meeting, which increased from 44% to 54%.

REFERRALS – REPORTING ITEM 1

Item 1. The number of referrals for initial evaluations in total and disaggregated by referral source

In FY2021, there were 31,992 referrals to the EI Program. Nearly two-thirds of them were boys, which is consistent with scientific and clinical knowledge of the prevalence of disability in the population. English was the dominant language for 64% of families referred. About half of the remaining referrals (17%) were from Spanish-speaking families. Data on source of referral are unreliable because there is no way to know if the referral “source” was acting at the recommendation of a pediatrician or childcare provider. Most referrals were from EI provider agencies (64%) and parents/families (18%).

INITIAL EVALUATIONS – REPORTING ITEM 2

Item 2. The number of initial evaluations conducted, including the number of such evaluations that resulted in a determination that the child was eligible for the Early Intervention Program.

A Multidisciplinary Evaluation (MDE) is performed by a team of qualified professionals from different disciplines who assess the child’s functioning in the five developmental domains: physical, cognitive, communication, social-emotional, and adaptive. The results of the MDE will be used to determine the child’s eligibility for the EI Program, based on eligibility criteria established by New York State.

During FY2021, 24,313 MDEs were completed. More than half (57%) of the children evaluated were determined eligible for the program. Eligibility was higher among White and Black children (59% and 61%, respectively), than among Latinx (53%) and Asian/Pacific Islander/Native American (56%) children. Slightly more boys than girls were determined eligible (60% vs 52%), and eligibility was highest among children whose dominant language was neither English nor Spanish.

IFSP MEETINGS – REPORTING ITEMS 3-4

Item 3. The number of IFSP meetings convened less than or equal to 45 calendar days from the date of referral.

Item 4. The number of IFSP meetings that were convened more than 45 calendar days from the date of referral.

The Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) is a written plan that identifies the EI services the child and family will receive. Federal law requires that the initial IFSP meeting (during which the IFSP is developed) must be convened within 45 calendar days of the date the child is referred to the EI Program.

During FY2021, there were 12,529 initial IFSP meetings, of which 89% occurred within 45 days of the date of referral or at a later date due to family reasons, as defined by Federal regulations. IFSPs delayed beyond 45 days for reasons that were not family-driven occurred most often among Black children (13%), and least often among White children (9%). Delayed IFSP meetings were less common among children with languages other than English and Spanish.

ACTIVE IFSP – REPORTING ITEM 5

Item 5. The total number of children who have an active IFSP (i) during the reporting period and (ii) as of June 30 of the reporting period.

A total of 30,424 children had an active IFSP in FY2021, of whom 16,334 were active on June 30, 2021. White and Latinx children each comprised approximately one-third of children with active IFSPs.

TIME TO FIRST SERVICE – REPORTING ITEM 6

Item 6. The average number of calendar days between the date of the initial IFSP meeting and the date children begin receiving Early Intervention services.

On average, children began receiving EI services within 15.9 days of their initial IFSP meeting, down from 18.4 in FY2020. Compared to White children, average time to service was two to three days longer for Black and Latinx children and two days shorter for Asian/Pacific Islander/Native American children. It was longer for children who speak Spanish (17.7 days) or English (15.9 days) than for children who speak other languages (15.2 days).

AUTHORIZED SERVICES – REPORTING ITEM 7

Item 7. The number and percentage of children with IFSPs who, (i) during the reporting period and (ii) as of June 30 of the reporting period, have IFSPs that recommend certain authorized services.

All children with IFSPs received service coordination. In FY2021, the most frequently authorized services included speech-language pathology (86% of children), special instruction or applied behavior analysis (73%), occupational therapy (OT) (52%) and physical therapy (PT) (39%). Transportation services, provided to facilitate the child’s receipt of center-based group developmental services, were the next most common service (8%), with each of the other enumerated services used by fewer than 5% of children.

- Higher percentages of White children received PT and lower percentages received speech-language pathology and special instruction compared to children of other races.
- Higher percentages of boys than girls received OT, special instruction, and speech-language pathology, and a lower percentage received PT.
- Higher percentages of children from English-dominant families received OT compared to children whose families speak other languages.
- Compared to children from English-dominant families, a lower percentage of children from Spanish-speaking families received PT, and higher percentages received special instruction and speech-language pathology.

Approximately one-third of families choose to receive ABA services for 5 - 10 hours per week and two-thirds choose to receive ABA services for 10 or more hours per week.

TIMELINESS OF ALL SERVICES – REPORTING ITEM 8

Item 8. The number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were, during the reporting period, receiving in full the early intervention authorized services as recommended in their IFSPs within 30 days of the meeting; the number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were receiving in part such services within 30 days of such meeting and the number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were awaiting the provision of such services after 30 days of such meeting.

Almost all children (95%) start services within 30 days of their IFSP meeting, but only 54% receive their full package of services within that time frame (an increase over 44% in FY2020). Among Black children, 44% receive their full package of services within that time frame. Higher percentages of girls (56% vs 52% for boys) and of children who speak languages other than English (59% vs 52% and 51% for English- and Spanish-speaking children, respectively) received their full package of services within 30 days of IFSP. Reasons for children not receiving all services in 30 days include authorizations for team meetings for interventionists, which do not occur until the child has been receiving services for some time, as well as large service packages with multiple services to be staffed.
