***Discussion Items***

1. Safety
  - a. The board discussed the recent crashes and safety in the industry.
    - i. Members shared new initiatives that they have implemented at their companies regarding driver safety.

- ii. There was a discussion regarding the identification of drivers who are potentially dangerous, have been disciplined by other trade waste companies, or dismissed due to unsafe driving practices.
  - b. The fifth safety symposium will be held on October 18, 2018. It will focus on DOT roadside inspections.
- 2. Commission meeting later in the day on June 28<sup>th</sup>
  - a. Rate cap rule will be voted on at the meeting.
  - b. Organics rule will be voted on at the meeting.
- 3. Emissions law: BIC City Administrative Procedure Act hearing re: financial hardship waiver took place on June 20, 2018
  - a. The Commission heard and is now considering the industry's comments and the rule will not be voted on at the June 28<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- 4. Customer register: 2nd quarter (April 1 – June 30) is due on July 31, 2018
