




... it is a time to celebrate the immense contributions of the AANHPI community to NYC Emergency Management, New York City, and the United States.




Ready New York Presenter Training



to promote the NYC CERT program.







THINGS TO KNOW

How To Request NYC CERT

If approached to support an event in your community, the following steps must be taken:

- Event organizer submits an official request using the <u>NYC CERT External Request Form</u>.
- NYC CERT Leadership should not submit form on behalf of the event organizer.



 For events lead by a NYC CERT Division, volunteer leadership (Ready New York Liaison, if a preparedness event) should submit this <u>Event</u> <u>Request form</u>

NYC CERT program staff will review all requests. If approved, program staff will add the volunteer opportunity to the NYC CERT Event Calendar with a registration link. If more details are required for approval, program staff will use the contact information provided in the request form to connect with the organizer.


