
About this report

New York City Charter section 20-d(e) requires the Office of Nightlife at the NYC Mayor's Office of Media and Entertainment to publish a semi-annual report of Multi-Agency Response to Community Hotspot (M.A.R.C.H.) operations beginning in 2020.

This report covers the period from January 1 through June 30, 2021. During that period, one M.A.R.C.H. operation was conducted at a nightlife establishment in April 2021. The Covid-19 pandemic and ongoing restrictions on indoor activity in nightlife establishments during this period continued to limit M.A.R.C.H. operations of nightlife establishments.

Q1–Q2 2021 Operations by ZIP Code








April
