<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> 420 individuals were placed directly from Narco Freedom or Interline sites into permanent housing. Of these, 417 received vouchers and 6 were placed in supportive housing.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> This category includes both rooms and apartments. It also includes former <u>SEPS</u> and <u>LINC</u> vouchers; both programs were replaced by CityFHEPS. Prior to this consolidation, 736 former TQH tenants were provided SEPS vouchers and 12 were provided LINC vouchers.

- Former TQH sites that have been sold and converted to single family homes or apartment buildings registered with HPD, often undergoing significant renovations or a complete demolition in the process.
- Former TQH sites that have been reassigned to other forms of monitoring.
- Former TQH sites with a longstanding active vacate order.
