#### **Wireless Emergency Alert System Testing**

FEMA, in coordination with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), will conduct a nationwide test of the Wireless Emergency Alert System (WEA) on **August 11 at approximately 2:20 PM**. The WEA system is used to warn the public about dangerous weather, missing children, and other emergencies by targeting cell phones. For example, you likely received the most recent WEA issued by our Public Warning Team that encouraged New Yorkers to conserve energy.

If you are interested in participating, please complete the following steps no later than **Thursday, August 5**:

- Upon arrival on Event the Volunteer Lead should check in with Watch Command by calling (718)-422-8700 or Using your 700 MHz Radio on the CW Channel and provide the following information:
  - Your name
  - CERT Division
  - Location
  - Volunteer assignment
  - Arriving on scene
  - How many volunteers are with you
  - Your contact information

The safety of all members is the top priority at all times.
