DEP to Kick Off Five-Borough Community Outreach Tour

Opportunity for Residents to Discuss Water Projects and Initiatives with New DEP Commissioner

Environmental Protection Commissioner Cas Holloway today announced a series of community meetings to be held in each of the five boroughs to discuss Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) projects and initiatives. Open to the public, the meetings will focus on current and planned water and sewer capital upgrades, customer service initiatives, and the water rate study the DEP recently completed. These meetings will be in addition to the planned water rate hearings in the spring, though customers will be able to ask questions about water rates and provide input, as DEP begins the annual water and sewer rate-setting process for Fiscal Year 2011. The meetings are also a chance for DEP to hear directly from our customers and to address their guestions and concerns."
