

FAMILY JUSTICE CENTERS

If you are a victim of domestic violence, elder abuse, or sex trafficking, you can go to a NYC Family Justice Center and meet with a prosecutor, speak with a trained counselor, and/or get social services all in one place. Services are free and provided regardless of immigration status or language. If you have children ages 3 and older, they can play in a children's room while you receive services.
