

Know Your Rights Forums

The NYC Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MOIA) promotes the well-being of NYC's immigrant communities by recommending policies and managing programs that help to successfully integrate immigrant New Yorkers into the civic, economic, and cultural life of the city.

Did you know?

NYC will protect the confidentiality of all New Yorkers seeking city services, regardless of Immigration Status. (NYC Executive Orders 34 & 41)

All City agencies that provide services to the public must have a plan to ensure New Yorkers who do not speak English can still access their services (NYC Executive Order 120) and translate their most commonly distributed materials into the top 10 citywide languages: Spanish, Chinese, Russian, Bengali, Arabic, Urdu, French, Polish, Haitian Creole, and Korean. (Local Law 30)

Host a Know Your Rights Forum

MOIA partners with city agencies, community-based organizations, and groups to host educational forums designed to educate NYC's immigrant communities on services and resources available to them. These Know Your Rights Forums are tailored around the interests of the community and feature presentations by City agency representatives and others. All MOIA-coordinated Know Your Rights Forums will include an overview of the Executive Orders outlined above and a summary of MOIA programs: IDNYC, ActionNYC, NYCitizenship, We Speak NYC and volunteer opportunities.
