Worldwide Delegation of Mayors Convene in New York City to Discuss Best Practices for Fostering Equitable, Sustainable and Livable Cities

NEW YORK— Mayor Bill de Blasio and the City of New York will host 80 Mayors and leaders from around the world as part of the World Cities Summit Mayors Forum from June 8-10, 2015. As winner of the second Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize, New York City will host this year's Forum titled "Innovative Cities of Opportunity," a discussion of best practices in urban policy innovation and collaboration among city leaders. Mayors from six continents will be present to discuss issues relating to housing and economic development, transportation and mobility, sustainability and resiliency, and education and competitiveness.
