December 9, 2023 — The New York City Emergency Management Department today issued a**travel** advisory for Sunday, December 10 and Monday, December 11. The National Weather Service has issued a Flood Watch in effect citywide from 4 p.m. Sunday to 6 a.m. Monday for 2 to 3 inches of rain. A High Wind Watch is also in effect for Brooklyn and Queens from 4 p.m. Sunday to 6 a.m. Monday for sustained winds of 30 to 40 mph and gusts up to 60 mph.








Brooklyn Leadership Meeting

How To Request NYC CERT

- Event organizer submits an official request using the NYC CERT External Request Form.
- NYC CERT Leadership *should not* submit form on behalf of the event organizer.
- For events lead by a NYC CERT Division, volunteer leadership (Ready New York Liaison, if a preparedness event) should submit this Event



Request form

NYC CERT program staff will review all requests. If approved, program staff will add the volunteer opportunity to the NYC CERT Event Calendar with a registration link. If more details are required for approval, program staff will use the contact information provided in the request form to connect with the organizer.


