  - NYC CERT Leadership submits form on behalf of the event organizer.

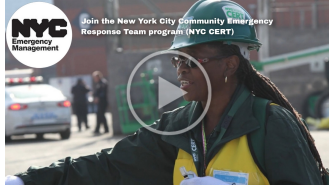

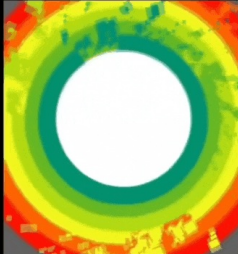
