eFiling Authentication Forms and Limited Alteration Applications Customer Service




Starting Monday, <u>March 22, 2021</u>, all **eFiling Authentication Forms** are required to be submitted via the <u>DOB Help Form</u>.

The help form should also be used to submit audit questions, civil penalty review requests, supersede/withdrawal requests and other general inquiries specific to Limited Alteration Applications.

eFiling Authentication Forms that were mailed or hand-delivered <u>before</u> March 22 will be processed.
