



The Commission may prescribe additional conditions and safeguards to minimize adverse effects on the character of the surrounding area and to improve the quality of the site configuration.












Map 1 - Special Downtown Jamaica District



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

Accordingly, there will now be three categories of energy code compliance review based on whether it's a new building, alteration or 1, 2, or 3 family home. There will be a fee associated with each such category of review. This fee has not been amended since it was adopted in 2014. The creation of separate categories and associated fees will cover the current workload and staffing needed to ensure compliance with code requirements.

The Department of Buildings' authority for these rules is found in sections 643 and 1043 of the New York City Charter and section 103.3 of the New York City Energy Conservation Code.

Pursuant to section 1043(d)(4)(iii) of the New York City Charter, this proposed rule is not subject to review under Charter section 1043(d).
