During the second half of 2012, three (3) West of Hudson Future Stormwater Controls Program resolutions were passed by the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors

**Resolution Number 2153** – The CWC Board of Directors approved funding to Kenneth Hoffman in an amount not to exceed Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Five Dollars (\$8,800.00) for eligible construction costs associated with a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan required solely by DEP. The property is located in the Town of Kortright, Delaware County.

**Resolution Number 2154** – The CWC Board of Directors approved a not-to-exceed amount of Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$3,300.00) to Delaware Park Ltd (Margaretville Carwash) for additional repairs to the stormwater basin damaged by Tropical Storm Irene which was required by a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan solely required by DEP. The project is located in the Village of Margaretville, Delaware County.

**Resolution Number -2192** – The CWC Board of Directors approved a not-to-exceed amount of Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$220,673.54) for the Prattsville Plaza for eligible costs incurred solely due to DEP requirements for design and construction of new stormwater controls related to the building of a strip mall style building and parking lot. The property is located in the Town of Prattsville, Greene County.

During the second half of 2012, the CWC Board of Directors approved one (1) resolution related to the Stormwater Retrofit Program:

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**Resolution Number 2169** – The CWC Board of Directors approved an additional \$4,869.57 for a full time onsite inspector due to the damages from Tropical Storms Irene and Lee for a total not-to-exceed amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Six Hundred and Twelve Dollars and Eighty-Seven Cents (\$225,612.87) with Ulster County for the Glenford-Wittenberg Road stormwater retrofit project.

Seventy-three (73) stormwater retrofit projects have been completed since 2000 under the CWC Stormwater Retrofit Program and ten stormwater retrofit projects are open – (7) construction projects and three (3) Planning and Assessment projects. The table below provides a summary status of active stormwater retrofit construction projects.
