- Lock your car doors
- DO NOT leave your car running unattended warming up
- DO NOT leave valuables in view
- Remove the valet key from glove compartment

PHONE SCAMS COME IN MANY FORMS

- Be wary if an unknown person calls requesting payment for the following:
 - A relative or friend has been arrested or in an accident
 - An outstanding bill and unless you pay, your service will be shut off
 - Unpaid taxes owed to the IRS
 - Unclaimed Lottery or sweepstakes winnings
- Use caution if the caller requests payment by using a Green Dot Card, Western Union, Money Orders, or Bank Wires

MOST STOLEN PROPERTY WAS UNATTENDED

- Never leave your purse or wallet unattended in shopping carts, strollers, parks, or areas accessible to others
- Never leave your cell phone unattended
