- **Have a plan.** Make an emergency plan that best suits your needs and outlines what to do, where to go, and how to communicate with your support network. Use the Ready New York guides and resources to help you get started.
- **Sign up for Notify NYC.** Get free emergency alerts and updates in your preferred language and format from the City’s free, official emergency communications program. Notifications are available in 14 languages, including American Sign Language (ASL) video format and audio format.
