To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing regarding the notice of late publication, dated January 23, 2023, that the Department of Investigation (DOI) received from the Department of Records and Information Service (DORIS) regarding DOI's annual Anti-Corruption Report.

Under Mayoral Executive Order No. 105 (1986), DOI is required to submit an annual Anti-Corruption Report to the Mayor. In June 2022, DOI submitted its 2021 Anti-Corruption Report to the Mayor. The topic of the report was cybersecurity risks and challenges at City agencies. Because the report contains confidential and sensitive cybersecurity information, public disclosure of the report would compromise City cybersecurity efforts. Accordingly, DOI is unable to transmit the report to DORIS for publication.
