



### Early Intervention Services

The DOHMH Bureau of Early Intervention provides early intervention services for infants and toddlers from birth to age 3 who have been diagnosed with a physical or mental condition that will likely result in a developmental delay. Children may also be eligible if their families suspect they have a developmental delay or disability but have not yet received a diagnosis. The Early Intervention Program is free and available to all eligible New York families, regardless of race, ethnicity, income, or immigration status.

As shown in the table below, in 2024, the total number of infants and toddlers diagnosed with ASD in New York City was 9,819, a decrease of 1% compared to 9,900 in 2023. Because of this very small change in numbers, the ASD diagnosis rate remained the same for both years, at 37 out of 1,000 children ages 0-3.

Data is reported by United Hospital Fund (UHF) neighborhood. Representative Zip Codes for each UHF neighborhood are included in the table. (Because UHFs represent small populations and even smaller 0-3 populations, large percentage changes may reflect a small number of children.)

There is no New York City or New York State-specific data on ASD prevalence, as ASD is not a reportable condition; and there is no national data specific to prevalence among children 0-3. Thus, we cannot compare the numbers observed in the NYC Early Intervention Program to a larger city, state or national context.
