- Customer Register due April 30, 2021
 - BIC has sent a Commission Directive that directs licensees to file Customer Registers by April 30, 2021. It is important that each company's Customer Registers remains updated.
- BIC Return to Office
 - o Remote workers returning to office on a limited basis starting May 3, 2021
 - o Public appointments not yet reinstated
