**Re: Annual Report on Criminal Prosecutions Pursuant to N.Y.C.  
Local Law 161 (2021)**

Dear Mayor Adams, Speaker Adams, and Ms. Logan:

Justice, fairness, and transparency remain at the core of our work in the Brooklyn District Attorney's Office. The Annual Report on Criminal Prosecutions, required under Local Law 161 (2021), is a crucial tool in evaluating our work and ensuring accountability to the public we serve.

This year's report reflects a major step forward. Thanks to the diligence and expertise of our data analysts, we have been able to report primarily from our own internal data, providing an increasingly detailed and accurate account of prosecutorial decision-making. As we continue to refine our reporting, we anticipate even more comprehensive, precise, and useful data disclosures next year as new case management systems come online.

However, despite our commitment to transparency, our ability to fully comply with the law's extensive reporting requirements remains constrained by limited resources. Last year, we requested funding for additional data analytics personnel and technology upgrades, including artificial intelligence tools that would significantly enhance our capacity to track, analyze, and report on case outcomes. That request remains unmet, limiting our ability to build a modern, data-driven infrastructure that meets both the legal mandates and public expectations for prosecutorial transparency.

We renew our request for this essential funding and urge the City to invest in the modernization of our data infrastructure. The work of tracking disparities, evaluating prosecutorial discretion, and ensuring public accountability is too important to leave underfunded.

Thank you for your continued partnership in strengthening the transparency, fairness, and effectiveness of our justice system.
