PROGRAM UPDATE



Due to the current climate and COVID-19 restrictions, you will notice that for all newly listen NYC CERT Volunteer Opportunities, there is a new question in the registration form titled COVID Affirmation.

ALL NYC CERT VOLUNTEERS MUST FOLLOW THESE PROCEDURES.

Upon registering for any opportunity, you must agree to the following:

All NYCEM CERT volunteers who will be in contact with City employees or the public must follow COVID safety protocols. I affirm that I have been fully informed by New York City Emergency Management of these protocols and that I will follow them.

As a NYCEM CERT volunteer, I hereby affirm:

1) I am fully vaccinated. I agree to still wear a mask at all times when on City property and when interacting with the public.

2) I am not fully vaccinated. I agree to wear a mask at all times when on City property and/or interacting with the public; AND, prior to deploying to a CERT activity I will undergo a PCR test and will only deploy if results are negative.




