DSNY ANNOUNCES START OF CURBSIDE E-WASTE COLLECTIONS IN NORTHERN BROOKLYN

Sanitation Commissioner Kathryn Garcia and Council Members Antonio Reynoso and Minority Leader Steven Matteo will mark the success of the first year of curbside e-waste collection on Staten Island and **announce the start of curbside e-waste collection in North Brooklyn.**

North Brooklynites can now go to nyc.gov/electronics and make an online reservation for the collection of up to 20 e-waste items covered under the state law. Residents may also call 311 for a reservation. Residents must place all items on their curb line the evening before their confirmed collection day. While certified specialists will erase computer hard drives after collection, it is highly recommended residents remove all private information from electronic items before pickup.
