


Map 2 - [date of adoption]

DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS BY THE CITY OF NEW YORK, PURSUANT TO SECTION 204 OF THE NEW YORK STATE EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEDURE LAW

Whereas, the New York City Department of Design and Construction (“DDC”), on behalf of the New York City Department of Transportation (“DOT”) and the City of New York (“City”), has proposed the acquisition of certain properties within the mapped street right-of-way of Olympia Boulevard from Norway Avenue to Hickory Avenue, Hickory Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard, Bionia Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard, Jerome Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard, Kensington Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard, Lamport Boulevard from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard, Mallory Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard, McClean Avenue from Norway Avenue to Hickory Avenue, Foch Avenue from Norway Avenue to Hickory Avenue; as shown on Acquisition and Damage Map 4256 (Capital Project: HWR1132B) in the Borough of Staten Island; and

Whereas, the New York State Eminent Domain Procedure Law (“EDPL”) sets forth uniform procedures for condemnations by municipalities throughout the State of New York, which also governs over this acquisition; and

Whereas, pursuant to the EDPL, the City is required to hold a public hearing to determine whether the public would be better served by the proposed acquisition of the above-mentioned properties, and the impact of such an acquisition on the neighborhood where the project is to be constructed; and

Whereas, the City held a public hearing, pursuant to EDPL Section 204 in relation to this acquisition on October 4, 2018, in the Borough of Staten Island. Having given due consideration to the complete hearing record, which includes, among other things, all documents submitted and all public comments, the City makes the following determination and findings concerning the above and below described acquisitions and project:

1. The public use and benefit of this project is for the reconstruction of roadways, sidewalks and curbs, and pedestrian ramps, and the installation of sanitary sewers, storm sewers, water mains and appurtenances in the Borough of Staten Island (the “Project”).
2. The proposed properties to be acquired are within the acquisition limits shown on the Damage and Acquisition Map 4256, as follows:
 - The bed of Olympia Boulevard from Norway Avenue to Hickory Avenue
 - The bed of Hickory Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard
 - The bed of Bionia Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard
 - The bed of Jerome Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard
 - The bed of Kensington Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard
 - The bed of Lamport Boulevard from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard
 - The bed of Mallory Avenue from McClean Avenue to Olympia Boulevard
 - The bed of McClean Avenue from Norway Avenue to Hickory Avenue
 - The bed of Foch Avenue from Norway Avenue to Hickory Avenue

The City selected these locations based on a need for the reconstruction of roadway, sidewalks and curbs, and pedestrian ramps, as well as the

installation of sanitary sewers, storm sewers, water mains and appurtenances. The City has also reviewed all potential alternate locations and has determined that no other sites are feasible for the Project.

The general effect on the neighborhood will be to improve current living conditions. The New York City Department of Transportation conducted an environmental review of the proposed property acquisition locations, in accordance with New York City Environmental Quality Review process (CEQR No. 15DOT010R). The New York City Department of Transportation as lead agency determined that the proposed project would not have a significant effect on the environment and published a Negative Declaration on April 3, 2015.

Comments and concerns raised by the property owners at the public hearing and through subsequent written submissions have been reviewed by the City. Property owners raised concerns about the potential for increased vehicular speed, commercial traffic, noise pollution and a possible increase in the rate of accidents as a result of the widening of the road, as well as concern that certain driveways may consequentially be reduced in length. Concerns were also raised about potential damages to the foundation of their properties due to vibrations from construction equipment and movement of large construction vehicles, particularly in older buildings. Questions about compensation amount, schedule and payment plans were also raised.

The City will work with all public and private parties involved in the project to minimize the impact of construction activities on the street, residents, and environment, and will work with other involved agencies and the community in order to review and address project-related concerns. The City continues to review its design plans and will make modifications addressing any issues whenever possible.

DETERMINATION:

Based upon due consideration of the record and the foregoing findings, it is determined that the City of New York should exercise its power of eminent domain to acquire the above-described properties in order to promote and permit the purposes of the Project to be achieved.

NOTICE:

Pursuant to EDPL Section 207, property owners have thirty (30) days from completion of the publication of this "Determination and Findings" to seek judicial review of this determination. This publication will be advertised in the City Record and Staten Island Advance newspapers.

The exclusive venue for the judicial review of this determination, pursuant to EDPL Sections 207 and 208 is the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court in the Judicial Department where any part of the property to be acquired is located.
