## NOTES

- This report is presented in accordance with the requirements set forth in section 17-199.12 of the administrative code of the city of New York.
- The report reflects data from the New York City Early Intervention (EI) Program for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025 (FY2025).
- The EI Program provides developmental services to children ages birth to three with developmental delays and disabilities.
- The EI Program does not provide medical services, nursing services, psychological services, or health services.
- This report includes all data required per section 17-199.12 of the New York City Administrative Code except the following items, which the NYS Early Intervention case management system does not capture:
  - Classification of children by housing status (e.g., homeless, residing in temporary housing)
  - Classification of homeless shelters, childcare providers, and nonprofit organizations as referral sources
  - IFSP Recommendations for sign language or cued language services
  - Service authorization data for children who have transferred to another NY EI jurisdiction
- If a category contains between one and five children or allows another category to be narrowed to between one and five children, the number has been replaced with an asterisk. A category that contains zero children has been reported as zero, unless such reporting would violate any applicable provision of federal, state, or local law relating to personally identifiable information.

## INTRODUCTION

The Early Intervention (EI) Program is a federal entitlement program created as Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act to provide services to children under three years old with developmental delays and disabilities. In New York City, the EI Program is administered by the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Bureau of Early Intervention. EI services, which are provided through a network of agencies in contract with the NYS Department of Health, are available regardless of families' race, ethnicity, income, or immigration status, at no cost to them.

The Bureau of Early Intervention is committed to ensuring that all eligible children have access to EI services and addressing historical racial disparities. Disparities are greatest for Black children, who in 2023 represented 21% of the birth to three years population in New York City but only 19% of children referred to EI. However, 19% is an improvement from the 17% consistently observed through 2019, reflecting the Bureau's concentrated efforts in this area. In recent years, the Bureau has strengthened its community outreach and developed partnerships with community organizations, collective impact groups, and other City agencies to address misconceptions and stigma about the EI Program. In 2021-2025, new partnerships with pediatric primary care practices at hospital systems serving communities with low rates of referral focused on increasing referral and retention in the evaluation process. The Bureau also continues its academic collaborations with CUNY and SUNY, encouraging dissemination of best practices and engagement of graduating students to work in the EI Program.

## FY2025 Highlights

Referrals declined by 13%, dropping from 32,868 in FY2024 to 28,609 in FY2025. This decrease may have stemmed from several intersecting factors. A primary contributor is the continued population decline in New York City, particularly among young children. In 2023, the number of children under age 3 fell by 6.1% compared to the previous year. Additionally, policy changes in FY2025 may have altered referral submission procedures, further impacting totals. The major transition from the New York Early Intervention System (NYEIS) to the EI-Hub in October 2024 also disrupted referral workflows, resulting in reduced activity during the changeover period. Collectively, these demographic, procedural, and technical shifts help explain the significant drop in referrals.

The number of multidisciplinary evaluations received also declined, from 26,868 in FY2024 to 20,769 in FY2025. However, the percentage of evaluated children found eligible rose slightly, from 57% to 64%. Meanwhile, the number of children receiving services decreased from 33,485 to 31,559. These reductions are partly attributable to the data system transition from NYEIS to the EI-Hub, which introduced new processes and temporarily affected program operations.

The proportion of initial IFSPs completed within 45 days dropped slightly from 87% in FY2024 to 81% in FY2025.

## REFERRALS – REPORTING ITEM 1

**Item 1. The number of referrals for initial evaluations in total and disaggregated by referral source**

In FY2025, the EI Program received 28,609 referrals, a 13% decrease from the 32,868 referrals recorded in FY2024. Child and family trends were consistent with previous years. Nearly two-thirds of referrals were boys, which is consistent with the prevalence of disability in the population. English was the dominant language for 64% of families referred. About half of the remaining referrals (21%) were from Spanish-speaking families (similar to FY2024), and Latinx children made up the single largest racial/ethnic category of referrals, accounting for 40%. EI providers were the leading source of referrals, contributing 42% of the total. Hospitals and doctors together made up 20% of referrals in FY2025, a modest increase from 18% in FY2024.

## INITIAL EVALUATIONS – REPORTING ITEM 2

### Item 2. The number of initial evaluations conducted, including the number of such evaluations that resulted in a determination that the child was eligible for the Early Intervention Program.

A Multidisciplinary Evaluation (MDE) is performed by a team of qualified professionals from different disciplines who assess the child's functioning in the five developmental domains: physical, cognitive, communication, social-emotional, and adaptive. The results of the MDE will be used to determine the child's eligibility for the EI Program, based on eligibility criteria established by New York State.

In FY 2025, 20,769 MDEs were completed. Of the children evaluated, 64% were determined eligible for the program, an increase from 57% in FY2024. Eligibility was higher among Black children (68%) than among White (66%), Latinx (62%) and Asian/Pacific Islander/Native American (60%) children. More boys than girls were determined eligible (66% vs 61%), and eligibility was highest among children whose dominant language was neither English nor Spanish.

## IFSP MEETINGS – REPORTING ITEMS 3-4

### **Item 3. The number of IFSP meetings convened less than or equal to 45 calendar days from the date of referral.**

### **Item 4. The number of IFSP meetings that were convened more than 45 calendar days from the date of referral.**

The Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) is a written plan that identifies the EI services the child and family will receive. Federal law requires that the initial IFSP meeting (during which the IFSP is developed) must be convened within 45 calendar days of the date the child is referred to the EI Program.

During FY2025, there were 12,937 initial IFSP meetings, of which 81% occurred within 45 days of the date of referral, or later due to family-driven reasons, as defined by Federal regulations. IFSPs delayed beyond 45 days for reasons that were not family-driven were most common among White children (22%) and least common among Latinx children (16%) and children who speak Spanish (15%). This marks a shift from FY2024, when such delays were most frequent among Black children (17%) and least frequent among Asian children (11%).

**Item 5. The total number of children who have an active IFSP (i) during the reporting period and (ii) as of June 30 of the reporting period.**

In FY2025, a total of 31,559 children had an active Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP), with 17,078 remaining active as of June 30, 2025. White and Latinx children each represented roughly one-third of the total, consistent with the distribution observed in FY2024.

## TIME TO FIRST SERVICE – REPORTING ITEM 6

**Item 6. The average number of calendar days between the date of the initial IFSP meeting and the date children begin receiving Early Intervention services.**

On average, children began receiving EI services within 22.6 days of their initial IFSP meeting, almost identical to the 22.5 days in FY2024. Compared to White children, the average time to service in FY2025 was six days longer for Black children and five days longer for Latinx children, reflecting a nearly identical pattern to FY2024. In FY2025, Asian, Pacific Islander, and Native American children had service timelines comparable to White children, averaging 20.3 and 19.7 days, respectively. However, this differed from FY2024, when Asian, Pacific Islander, and Native American children had service timelines approximately two days shorter than those of White children.

## AUTHORIZED SERVICES – REPORTING ITEM 7

### **Item 7. The number and percentage of children with IFSPs who, (i) during the reporting period and (ii) as of June 30 of the reporting period, have IFSPs that recommend certain authorized services.**

All children with IFSPs received service coordination. In FY2025, the most frequently authorized services included speech-language pathology (85% of children), special instruction and applied behavior analysis (84%), occupational therapy (OT) (47%) and physical therapy (PT) (33%). Transportation services offered to support access to center-based group developmental programs were the next most frequent, received by 9% of children. All other listed services were provided to fewer than 5% of children. The distribution of services remained largely consistent with FY2024, showing only slight declines overall, with the exception of occupational therapy, which decreased from 56% in FY2024 to 47% in FY2025.

- Higher percentages of White children received PT and lower percentages received speech-language pathology and special instruction compared to children of other races.
- Higher percentages of boys than girls received OT, special instruction, and speech-language pathology, and a lower percentage received PT.
- Compared to children from English-dominant families, a lower percentage of children from Spanish-speaking families received PT, and higher percentages received special instruction and speech-language pathology.

Overall, FY2025 service utilization patterns remained consistent with those observed in FY2024, showing similar trends across race, gender, and primary language groups.

## TIMELINESS OF ALL SERVICES – REPORTING ITEM 8

**Item 8. The number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were, during the reporting period, receiving in full the early intervention authorized services as recommended in their IFSPs within 30 days of the meeting; the number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were receiving in part such services within 30 days of such meeting and the number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were awaiting the provision of such services after 30 days of such meeting.**

Nearly all children (92%) start at least some of their authorized services within 30 days of their IFSP meeting, and 55% receive their full package of services in that timeframe, comparable to FY2024's rate of 56%. A higher proportion of White (60%) and Asian (59%) children received their complete services within 30 days, compared to Latinx (52%) and Black (47%) children. Children who speak languages other than English or Spanish were also more likely to receive all services within 30 days (59%), compared to 54% of English-speaking children and 55% of Spanish-speaking children. Rates were similar for boys and girls. Reasons for children not receiving all services in 30 days include waits for in-person service availability; authorizations for team meetings for interventionists, which do not occur until the child has been receiving services for some time; large service packages with multiple services to be staffed; child illness; conflicting medical appointments; and family vacations.
