The New York City Charter, Chapter 49, Section 1133, requires that agencies submit to the Department of Records and Information Services (DORIS) all reports, documents, studies and publications required by local law, executive order, or mayoral directive to be published, issued, or transmitted to the City Council or Mayor, within 10 business days of their publication.
