

NOAA predicts above-normal 2022 Atlantic Hurricane Season



NOAA announced its initial outlook for the 2022 Atlantic hurricane season during a news conference on May 24 at the New York City Emergency Management Department in Brooklyn, New York. Speakers gave the official forecast including the number of named storms and hurricanes expected for the 2022 Atlantic hurricane season. The Atlantic Hurricane season begins on June 1 and ends on November 30.

WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERT (WEA) SYSTEM TEST Tuesday, June 1 at 2 p.m.



NYC Emergency Management will be testing the Wireless Emergency Alert (WEA) system this week.

Only cell phones with the Wireless Emergency Alert (WEA) test setting enabled on their smartphones will receive the test.

Enabled devices will receive an alert that includes a text-like message that reads "TEST" and is accompanied by a loud tone signal and vibration. No action is required. This is only a test.



May Is National STOP THE BLEED® Month




This is the fourth year of National STOP THE BLEED Month. During this month, learn the basic skills necessary to control bleeding from accidents and injuries. Knowing


CERT Orientation


