RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered a proposal for the long term loan of *Thomas Jefferson* (1833) by Pierre-Jean David (David D'Angers), City Council Chamber, City Hall to the New-York Historical Society, 170 Central Park West, Manhattan, submitted by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, represented by exhibits 793-H & I of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary approval to the removal of the artwork from the City Council Chamber with the understanding that the location will be further studied and, before the end of 2021, an appropriate location will be determined where it will remain accessible to the public.

The Commission notes the history of the artwork in City Hall, that it was gifted to the people of New York by one of the first Jewish officers in the U.S. military, Uriah Phillips Levy, in recognition of Thomas Jefferson's commitment to religious freedom, and that Jefferson was the author of the Declaration of Independence, a founding document of the United States. The Commission also recognizes the layered narratives and meanings assigned to this artwork and takes seriously the implications of monumentalizing figures who, despite espousing the virtues of freedom and democracy, prospered from the labor of enslaved people and upheld racist beliefs to justify the institution of slavery. The Commission acknowledges the passionate call from members of the City Council to remove the artwork from their chambers and to install it in a place where it can be contextualized and serve as an educational tool. The Commission also thanks the New-York Historical Society for its ongoing commitment to providing opportunities for the public to learn about and discuss the history of New York City and the Country.
