The City's Annual Disclosure Law requires all candidates for City elective office to file an annual disclosure report with the Board. The Annual Disclosure Law further requires the Board to publish a list of those candidates who did not file within 10 days of the filing deadline. <u>See</u> New York City Administrative Code Section 12-110(b)(2). Independent party candidates were required to file a report with the Board by June 26, 2023. The following candidates did not file a 2022 annual disclosure report with the Board within 10 days of that filing deadline:\*
