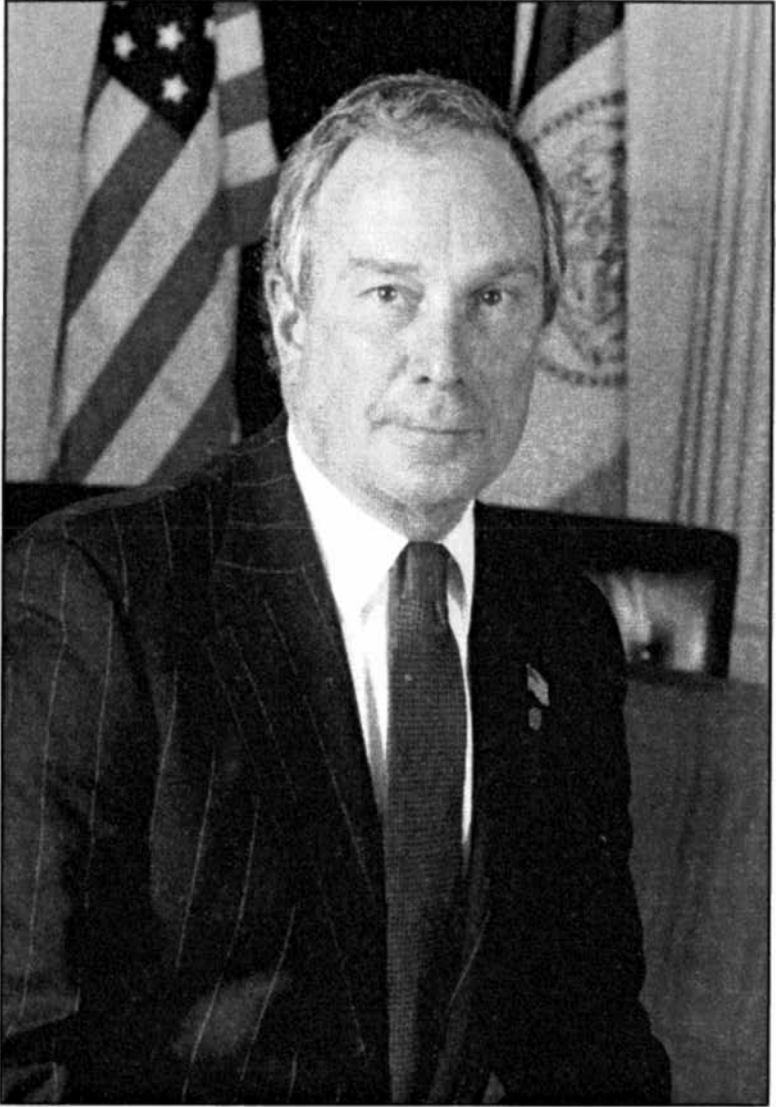

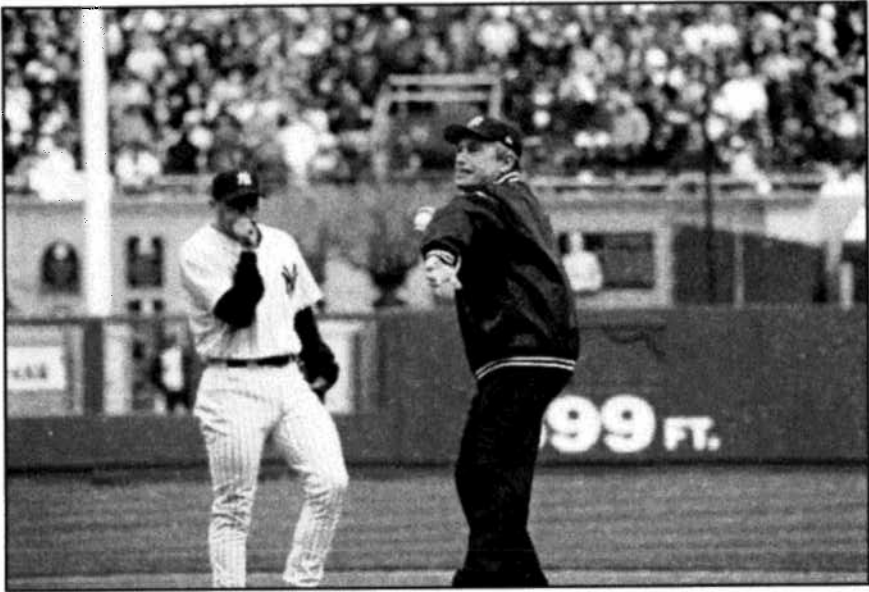

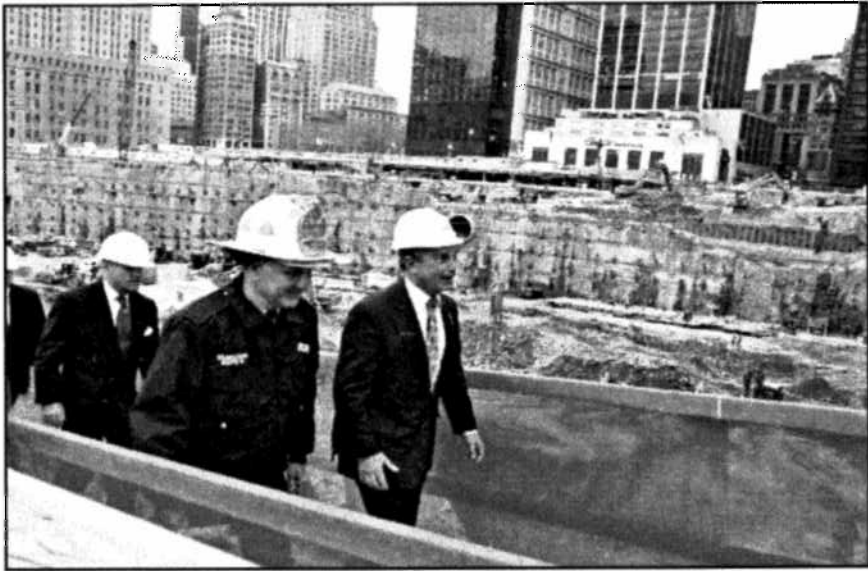

THE EURO

On January 1, 2002, the Euro, a common currency and legal tender, began circulating in 12 of the 15 member nations of the European Union (EU). Austria, Belgium, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, The Netherlands, Portugal, and Spain are the countries that adopted the Euro. Denmark, Sweden, and the United Kingdom have opted to keep their existing local currencies. At the time of its introduction, all transactions in the member nations were valued in Euro, and the "old" notes and coins of these countries were gradually withdrawn from circulation. The precise dates that each "old" currency ceased being legal tender varied from country to country.



The graphic symbol for the Euro resembles an "E" with two clearly marked, horizontal parallel lines across it. It was inspired by the Greek letter epsilon, in reference to the cradle of European civilization and to the first letter of the word 'Europe'. The parallel lines represent the stability of the Euro.

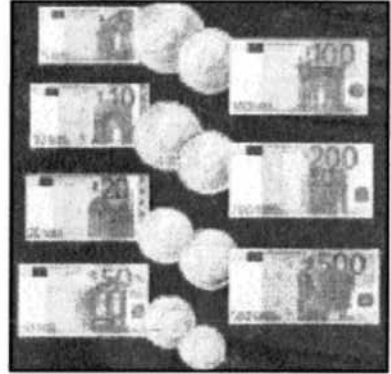
Euro Notes

The banknotes were designed as the result of a competition among professional note designers that was launched by the European Monetary Institute (EMI) in February 1996. The EMI Council announced the winning design by Robert Kalina of the Austrian Central Bank in December 1996 at the European Council in Dublin. Inspired by the theme "Ages and styles of Europe," his design depicts seven important architectural periods in Europe's cultural history.

There are seven Euro notes, and each note differs in size and color in proportion to its value. Unlike most country notes, famous people are not depicted. Rather, windows and gateways dominate the front side of each banknote as symbols of the spirit of openness and cooperation in the European Union. The reverse side of each banknote features a bridge from a particular age, a metaphor for communication among the people of Europe and between Europe and the rest of the world.

Euro Coins

There are eight denominations of Euro coins which vary in size, color and thickness according to their values. Luc Luyckx of the Royal Belgian Mint won a Europe-wide competition to design the Euro coins. All Euro coins bear a common side and a country-specific, national side. The common side displays one of three different maps along with the stars of the EU flag. The 1, 2 and 5 cent coins put emphasis on Europe's place in the world while the 10, 20 and 50 present the Union as a gathering of nations. The 1 and 2 Euro coins depict Europe without frontiers. Final designs were agreed upon at the European Council meeting in Amsterdam in June 1997



The reverse side of the coins, the national side, shows the twelve stars of the EU flag and the year of issue, plus a design reflecting the country in which the coins were produced. Euro coins can be used anywhere in the Euro area, regardless of their national sides.

Euro Facts

- For the January 1, 2002 launch of the Euro, 14.5 billion notes were printed valued at a total of €642 billion (\$565 billion). Fifty billion coins were minted with a total value of €15.7 billion.
- Laid end-to-end, the notes would reach from the Earth to the moon and back five times
- The coins weighed a total of 240,000 tons and could fill 10,000 heavy-duty trucks.

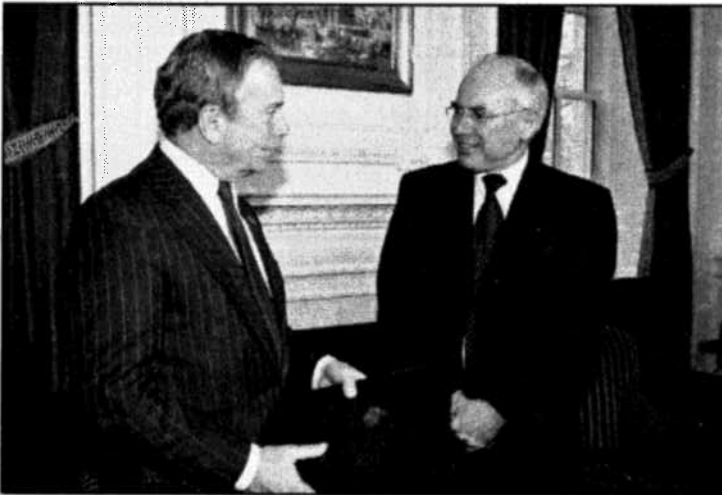

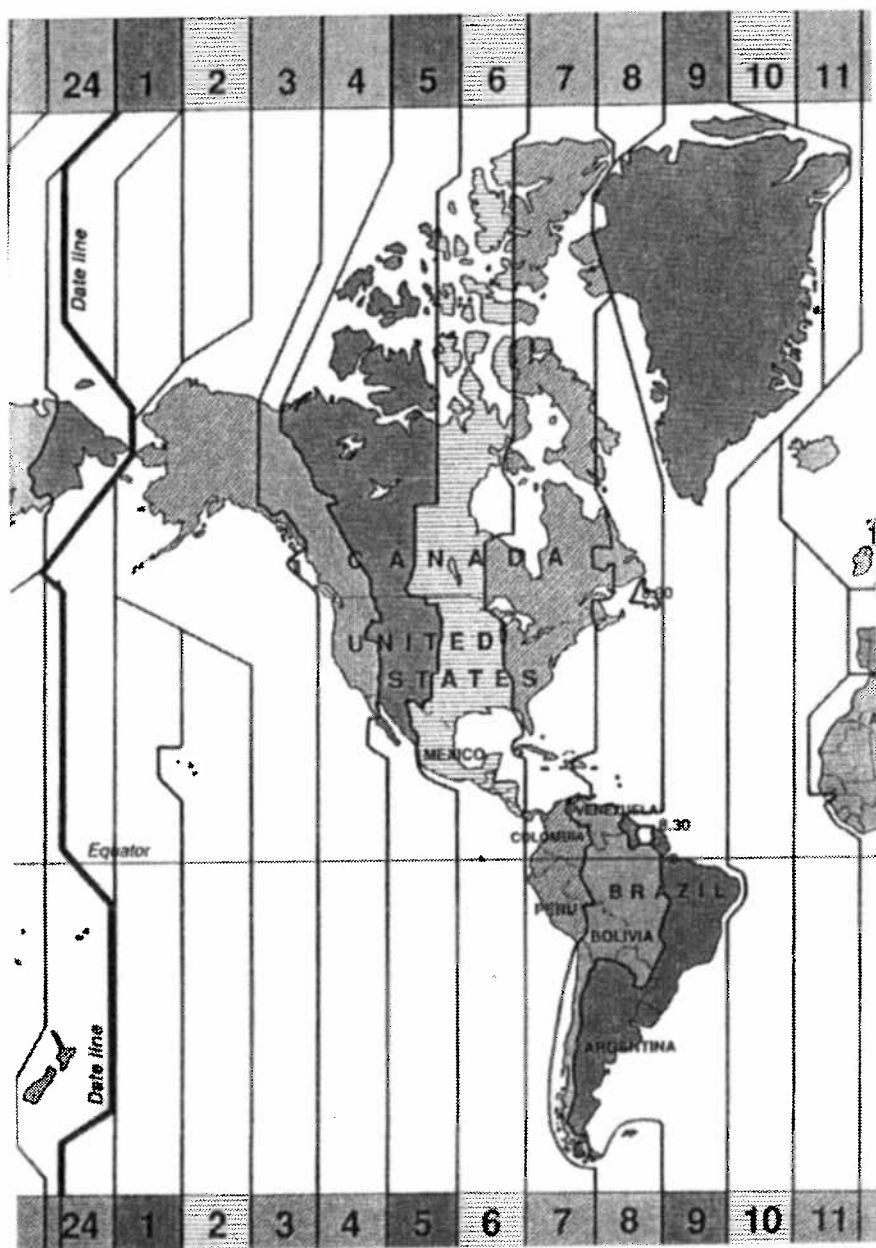

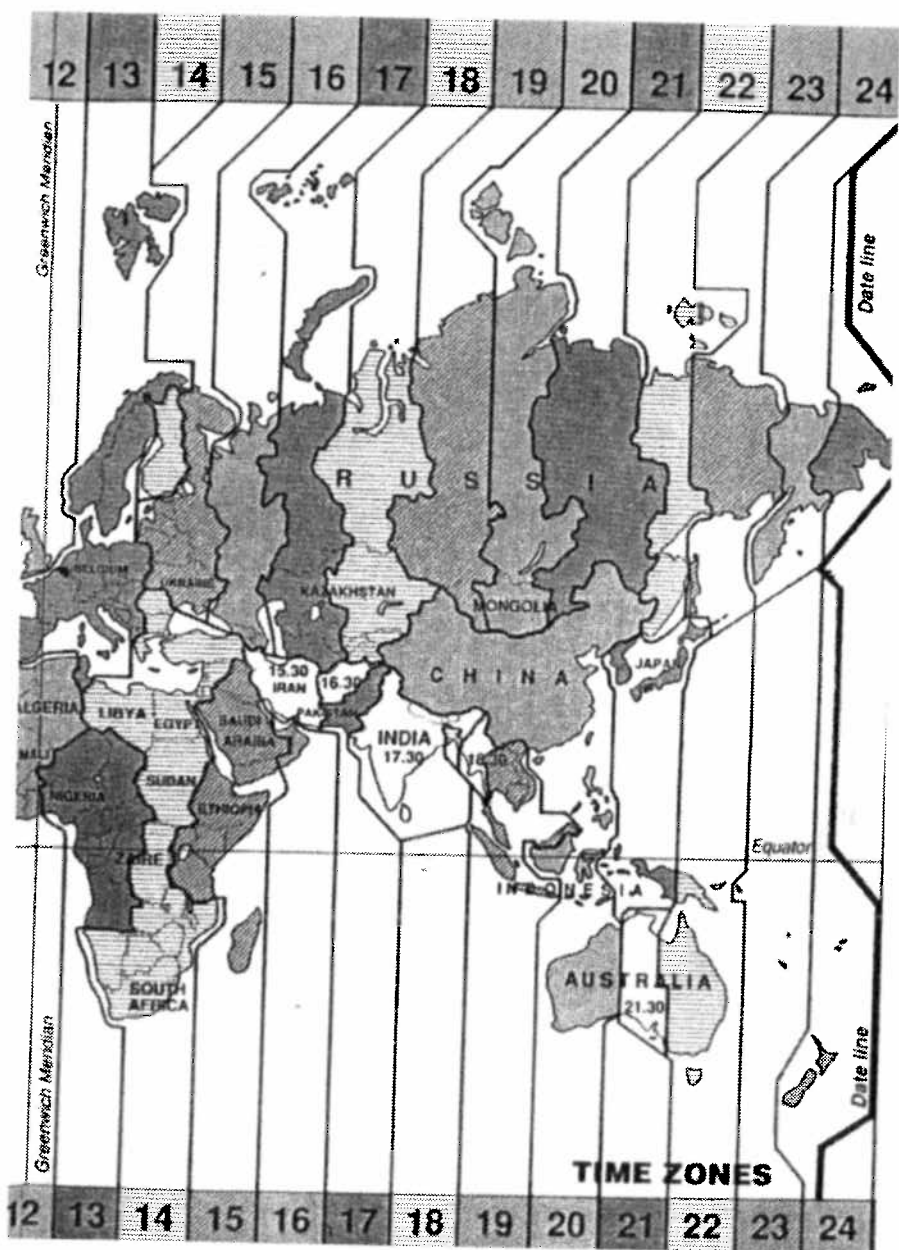

PROTOCOL POINTERS

New York City's Office of the Mayor's Office for Protocol receives numerous inquiries as to the proper protocol under a wide variety of circumstances, ranging from proper forms of address to concerns about appropriate gifts. This section includes an abbreviated description of answers to the most frequently asked questions received by this office.

COURTESY TITLES

1. *The Honorable*

Most high-ranking **American** officials, whether elected, appointed, or retired are addressed with the courtesy title, *The Honorable*, preceding their names. A partial list includes:

- Former Presidents
- Former Vice Presidents
- Cabinet Members and their Deputy Under Secretaries
- Ambassadors
- Former Supreme Court Justices
- All judges
- Members of Congress
- Heads of government agencies
- Governors
- Mayors
- Commissioners

The Honorable is occasionally used when addressing foreign diplomats as well:

- Cabinet officials
- Charge d'Affaires of ministerial level
- Heads of international organizations (including the United Nations) unless the individual is otherwise entitled to be addressed as His/Her Excellency

2. *His/Her Excellency*

Most high ranking foreign officials, whether in office or retired, **are** addressed as His/Her Excellency. Among those afforded these titles are:

Presidents
Prime Ministers
Premiers
Cabinet Officers
Ambassadors

American governors of the following states use the title *Excellency*:

New Hampshire
Massachusetts
South Carolina

3. *The Right Honorable*

This title is used when addressing the Prime Minister or Cabinet Officers within the British Commonwealth.

4. Forms of Address for *Royalty*

King/Queen - His/Her Majesty
Royal Prince/Princess or Prince Consort - His/Her Royal Highness
Prince/Princess (non-reigning) - His/Her Highness
Emperor/Empress - His/Her Imperial Majesty
