The New York City Charter, Chapter 49, Section 1133, requires that agencies submit to the Department of Records and Information Services (DORIS) all reports, documents, studies and publications required by local law, executive order, or mayoral directive to be published, issued, or transmitted to the City Council or Mayor, within 10 business days of their publication. For any report that is not received within 10 business days of the publication date, DORIS is required to email the agency to request the report, and to provide the text of that email in place of the report in the Government Publications Portal.

Report Description: Report including 1. the number of covered buildings where the owner applied for a certificate of no harassment disaggregated by whether the department issued a certificate of no harassment, a cure agreement was reached, or a waiver of a certificate of no harassment; 2. the location of buildings where the department determined that harassment had occurred, disaggregated by community board and council district disaggregated by whether such building was subject to a cure agreement; 3. metrics which the department determines appropriate to determine the preventive impacts of such program; 4. a determination, using such metrics, as to whether such program resulted in preventive impacts; 5. estimated costs of the program to the city; and 6. recommendations for improving the efficacy of such program if the pilot program continues
