

## April 2024 After-Action Report (AAR)

April was Volunteer Recognition Month, and NYC CERT members made their presence felt across the city with nearly 800 hours of engagement! The incredibly productive month was filled with nearly 320 hours of advanced training, exercises, and drills.

The highlight was spent at Gracie Mansion, where members were honored for their 2023 support, and over 25 members were trained to support the Conservatory's 2024 events. The event garnered over 73 hours reported. Point-to-Point Radio Training was not far behind, with over 72 hours of advanced training as CERT members learned proper communication protocols and standard operating procedures. CERT members spent over 46 hours and upgraded their skills at the FDNY Hands-Only CPR training. Independent study reached over 27 hours, leadership development logged over 6 hours, and radio call drills had 37 hours of communications skill sharpened. The collaboration with the

NYCEM's Strengthening Communities partner, South Bronx Emergency Network (SBEN), at the Bronx Borough Disasterville exercise was another highlight that logged over 14 hours of scenario emergency management, team building, and camaraderie.

Planned deployments had over 111 hours of CERT presence across New York City events. DEP support reached 33 hours in emergency deployment. Brooklyn Bikers had 24 hours of support for bike blessings. Earth Day celebrations, a resource fair, and Senator Persaud's Easter Egg Hunt added up over 39 hours of support in pedestrian safety and traffic management. Members also deployed for 60 hours engaged with the community at Ready New York Table events. Recruitment also reported 10 hours of community engagement.

All these deployments were successful thanks to the behind-the-scenes CERT Division preparation. Administrative duties logged over 80 hours of preparation for planned events with NYCEM staff, organization of Division reports, and preparing for team meetings. CERT Divisions reported 121 hours of monthly team meetings full of discussion of upcoming events, welcoming and acclimating new members, training, and planning the future of a successful team.

Keep up the exemplary work, Team. Your passion for making our city a more emergency-prepared and safer place is noted and appreciated. Thank you.



# THINGS TO KNOW



#### How To Request NYC CERT

If approached to support an event in your community, the following steps must be taken:

- Event organizer submits an official request using the <u>NYC CERT External Request Form</u>.
- NYC CERT Leadership *should not* submit form on behalf of the event organizer.
- For events lead by a NYC CERT Division, volunteer leadership (Ready New York Liaison, if a preparedness event) should submit this <u>Event</u> <u>Request form</u>

NYC CERT program staff will review all requests. If approved, program staff will add the volunteer opportunity to the <u>NYC CERT Event Calendar</u>

with a registration link. If more details are required for approval, program staff will use the contact information provided in the request form to connect with the organizer.


