Social Security Card

Visit the Social Security Administration's website at www.ssa.gov for instructions to obtain or replace a Social Security card.

Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)

If you are not eligible to apply for a Social Security card, you must obtain an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS).

- 1. Visit the IRS website at www.irs.gov.
- 2. Download and complete Form W-7, Application for IRS Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).
- Submit Form W-7 and supporting documents directly to the Internal Revenue Service at: Internal Revenue Service

Do not return Form W-7 to NYCERS.

- 4. Once you receive your ITIN, visit the IRS website at www.irs.gov and download Form W-8BEN, Certificate of Foreign Status of Beneficial Owner for United States Tax Withholding.
- 5. Complete and submit Form W-8BEN to NYCERS at 30-30 47th Ave., Suite 1010, Long Island City, NY 11101.
