

Local Law 112 of 2023 in relation to reporting on objections to orders for the abatement or remediation of lead conditions, January 1, 2025 through June 30, 2025

The New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (Health Department) submits this report pursuant to Local Law 112 of 2023, which requires the Department to report biannually on the number of objections to Health Department Orders for lead abatement or remediation received by the Health Department pursuant to paragraph 3 of subdivision d of section 173.13 of the health code. The report must include the number of such objections received from a housing development operated by the New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA), and the number of orders withdrawn in full by the Health Department, disaggregated by the following reasons: faulty paint sampling or testing by the Health Department; inconclusive or contradicting test results; and exemptions due to the date a tested dwelling was erected.

For the period January 1, 2025 through June 30, 2025:

- Number of objections received: 69
 - Housing operated by NYCHA: 25
 - Housing not operated by NYCHA: 44

Number of these objections that were withdrawn in full by the Health Department, with reason withdrawn:

- Number Withdrawn: 21
- Faulty paint sampling or testing by the Health Department: 0
- Inconclusive or contradicting test results: 21
- Exemptions due to the date a tested dwelling was erected: 0
