Type of request is only captured once an applicant begins the application interview, so applicants who do not reach the interview stage are not included in this data. These outcomes are reported at the request level. The same applicant may have requested multiple types of emergency assistance, some or all of which could have been accepted. Each distinct request type is included.

*Other Housing includes but is not limited to Security deposit, Broker's fees, Rent in advance to secure an apartment, and requests for supplemental rent issuances to applicants that recently received a rent issuance.

NOTE: During the January – March reporting period, many emergency assistance requests were rejected because of the availability of Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) and Regular Arrears Program (RAS) funds.
