April is Sexual Assault Awareness Month*

- **Someone in the United States is sexually assaulted every 109 seconds.¹**
- **Approximately two-thirds of all sexual assaults are committed by someone known to the victim.²**
- **Sexual Assault is any sexual activity involving a person who does not or cannot consent due to fear, coercion, age, illness, disability, and/or influence of alcohol or drugs.**
