

Converted MTS Permits and Approvals

- The Converted MTS will require state, federal and local permits and approvals.
- The MTS is subject to the Uniform Land Use Review Procedure (ULURP) as site selection for a capital project.
- The Converted MTS ULURP application was certified on November 15th, and the ULURP process is on-going.
- Queens Community Board 7 will hold meetings and a hearing to consider and vote on the ULURP application.
- The Converted MTS State environmental permit application (solid waste, air and marine) was submitted in November to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC).
- NYSDEC will hold a hearing and establish a public comment period on the Converted MTS permit application as part of its permit review process.
